

Adult/Gerontology Acute Care Nurse Practitioner (AGACNP) post-masters certificate

This certificate admits only in the summer semester. The basic program of study outlines the 20-23 credits needed to successfully complete the program part-time. Successful completion of 650 clinical hours is required.

Prerequisites:

- Must have one year of critical care experience (approximately 2080 hours) within the past five years is required
- Successful completion (grade of B or better) of courses equivalent to Advanced Physiology and Pathophysiology, Advanced Pharmacology for Nursing, and Advanced Health Assessment and Diagnostic Reasoning within the past five years
